

Access Routes to Registered Teacher Status (RTS)

The Faculty of Education is offering new Access Routes leading to eligibility for RAD Registered Teacher Status. As an RAD Registered Teacher, you will be able to enter students for RAD exams and be included on the RAD Register of Teachers. You will also join our professional membership network of over 8,000 teachers worldwide.

Our Access Routes follow a modular distance learning format so you can schedule your study around your professional and personal commitments. You will receive guidance from our experienced and highly qualified tutors to support your studies and assessment preparation.

Access Route (Degree Track)

This route is for you if you are a current student (or recent graduate) of a dance degree programme that includes modules in dance pedagogy and ballet technique as part of the course content. You will study three modules over two years comprising of Ballet Vocabulary: Foundations and Progressions, Ballet Technique: Movement Analysis for Performance and Teaching and Ballet Pedagogy: Theory to Practice.

Apply by: 29 February 2024

Starts: 8 April 2024

Access Route (Vocational Track)

This will run from 2025 and will offer a route for vocational dance students who are training at (or have recently graduated from) an accredited vocational dance training provider. It can be studied alongside your vocational training, so that once you have successfully completed your vocational training course and Access Route (Vocational Track) you will be eligible to apply for RAD RTS.
